The Landscape Architecture Program at WSU seeks applications for an Assistant or Associate Professor, depending upon qualifications. This is a 9 month, full-time tenure-track position.

The WSU Landscape Architecture Program values the holistic approaches required to address the substantive challenges of society, notably climate change, human health, food production, urbanization, and water use. The program seeks candidates who demonstrate deep awareness of these challenges, and the capacity to bridge innovative landscape design with ecological thinking. We are particularly interested in candidates who seek to explore and enliven design education; find opportunity in the complexity and overlap of ecological, social, aesthetic, and professional issues; and who can move fluidly among the “what,” “why,” and “how-to” of landscape architecture practice.

The Assistant/Associate Professor of Landscape Architecture position is one of a series of recent hires in the School of Design and Construction intended to strengthen expertise and further synchronistic relationships among School faculty. ### **Required for both Assistant and Associate Professor (successful Associate Professor candidate must currently have Associate Professor status or have Assistant Professor status for four or more years)**

Professional Master's Degree in Landscape Architecture (MLA), or a Master's or PhD degree in a related field and a professional Bachelor's of Landscape Architecture degree (BLA or BSLA) by employment start date; Demonstrated knowledge of contemporary and emerging landscape visualization and representation techniques and an ability to apply and integrate this knowledge in studio settings; Established or promising program of creative scholarship/research.

The Harvard University Graduate School of Design (GSD) invites nominations and applications for the position of Curator of the Loeb Fellowship. Now in its fifth decade, the Fellowship was founded with a gift from John and Frances Loeb. Over those five decades the Fellowship has offered the resources of Harvard to a diverse group of over 450 Loeb Fellows from 36 U.S. states and 18 countries. The Loeb Curator, in addition to providing leadership to and management of the Loeb Fellowship, will also be expected to contribute to the School through teaching and service to the GSD. The Loeb Curator will be appointed for an initial term of five years, and the position is renewable, contingent upon review and reappointment by the School. Full time residence in, or relocation to, the Boston metropolitan area is required. A Master's degree in a field of study taught at GSD is preferred. A concurrent faculty appointment in one or more Departments within the GSD, as appropriate to the curator's disciplinary and professional background, is provided with the Loeb Fellowship curator position. The faculty appointment will be reviewed in five years and is contingent on continuation of the staff appointment. Bachelors degree and proven leadership in an educational/design setting including architecture, landscape architecture, urban planning, urban design or related field is required. 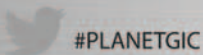

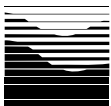
